VACANCIES ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE FRESNO WESTSIDE MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

FIREBAUGH, CALIFORNIA - The Fresno Westside Mosquito Abatement District has current and pending vacancies in its managing Board of Trustees. Two positions on the board to represent the county-at-large are currently vacant and another term will expire on 1/3/22 . The seven-member Board of Trustees oversees operations at the Fresno Westside Mosquito Abatement District and meets on the second Thursday of each month. The Fresno Westside Mosquito Abatement District covers nearly 1300 square miles of Western Fresno County including the cities of Firebaugh and Mendota, and the communities of Tranquility, Five Points, Three Rocks, and Oro Loma. The District conducts active surveillance of larval and adult mosquitoes as well as mosquito-borne diseases and reduces the mosquito population through application of Integrated Vector Management (IVM).

Trustees are appointed to a term of 2 or 4 years and serve without compensation (they are eligible for reimbursement of travel expenses). Interested parties should apply under “Fresno Westside Mosquito Abatement District” at <https://bosbcc.co.fresno.ca.us/> .
